

Living well together in a changing territory

Alpes et Azur LAG is located in the centre of Southern Alpes between the coastline and high mountains. This multi-coloured land is characterised by a mountainous rural life and an outstanding natural heritage : provençals mounts of Préalpes d'Azur, Alpes d'Azur red gorges, the Ubaye river and the Serre-Ponçon lake.

The territory faces several key issues and challenges specific to rural mountainous areas :

- A growing vulnerability to climate change
- A fragile natural heritage that shall be preserved
- Remoteness from urban centres and the proximity services they provide
- A complex and difficult mobility
- The fact that most economic sectors are undergoing radical change.



Local Development Strategy

The LAG aim is to anchor its identity as a dynamic and innovative land, remarkable regarding ecological and solidary transition :

- Living well together and improving quality of life
- Doing business in an environmental-friendly way and encouraging responsible economic sectors
- Gaining further insight into resources sustainability : better comprehending resources management and supporting the territory's resilience.

Strengthening ties and consolidating services for all

Developing, diversifying proximity services (businesses, social and health care, culture/sport, mobility, digital technology) and improving their access for all.
